- All APMS practices that existed in 2013/14, including the name of the contract provider
- Any new APMS practices since 2013/14 - up until and including 2020/21 - including the name of the contract provider
- Any change in provider of the APMS contracts since 2013/14 in relation to the two questions above – and the names of the new providers

Response

Some of the information you have requested is not held by the CCG because NHS England were the commissioners for General Practice in 2013/14.

NHS Kirklees CCG came into existence on 1 April 2021. Details relating to our predecessor CCGs (Greater Huddersfield and North Kirklees) can be found below:

North Kirklees: Broughton House practice is an APMS contract. This was awarded for delivery of primary care services by North Kirklees CCG to the current provider (Dr David Pundit Kaushal) from 1 April 2018. Before this, Locala CIC delivered this APMS contract.

Greater Huddersfield: On becoming delegated for primary care commissioning in 2016, Greater Huddersfield CCG had one APMS practice, The Whitehouse Centre, which was at that point, and continues to be, run by Locala. In addition to that, since 2016 there have been the following changes:

1st July 2018 – Oaklands Health Centre was awarded a temporary caretaker APMS contract to run Clifton House and Nook GMS practice, due to the Clifton House site closing.

1st April 2020 – Dr Jalil Ahmed was awarded an APMS contract to run the Nook Surgery.
