Request

Please may you provide me with:

- a) The number of GP surgeries which operate in your CCG as of July 2021, July 2020 and July 2019
- b) The number of GP surgeries which have hoists for disabled patients as of July 2021, July 2020 and July 2019
- c) The number of GP surgeries which have height adjustable beds for disabled patients July 2021, July 2020 and July 2019

Response

NHS Kirklees CCG came into existence on 1 April 2021. There are 64 practices currently operating (July 2021) in Kirklees.

For the previous years' information that you have requested, the answers provided relate to our predecessor CCGs, Greater Huddersfield (GHCCG) and North Kirklees (NKCCG).

NKCCG – 27 practices for July 2019 and the same in July 2020.

GHCCG – 37 practices for July 2019 and the same in July 2020.

The CCG does not hold information about the number of hoists and height adjustable beds available in each practice at any given time. You may wish to refer your request for this information to the practices directly. The following link shows the practices within Kirklees:
