Freedom of Information Act 2000 – Request for Information

Request

I am trying to determine the first 4 digits of the postcodes that were being served by Greater Huddersfield CCG and North Kirklees CCG before the merger. I cannot find any maps of the coverage to try and work these out or any documentation on the internet that provide the postcodes for the CCG, the data I am analysing covers all south west Yorkshire therefore, for example, Barnsley patients are included and I need to filter them out by only looking at patients in the two areas before the merger of the CCG.

Response

Greater Huddersfield CCG covered postcodes from HD1 to HD9 inclusive, and WF4. North Kirklees CCG covered WF12 to WF17 inclusive, BD4, BD11, BD12, and BD19. Not all of these postal areas were covered by the CCGs as some districts cross the Kirklees boundary. You may find the attached map of council wards helpful. Please note that some patients who are registered with a Kirklees GP may not reside within that boundary.
